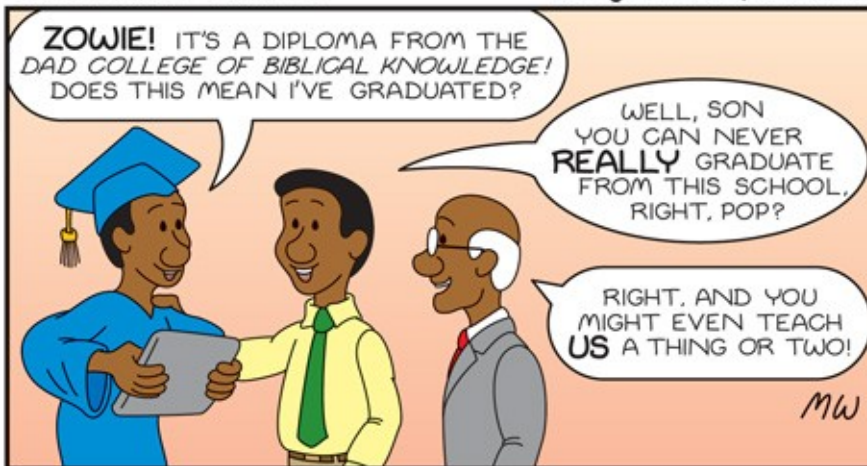

Youth Got Questions... Pastor Clarke has answers!

We're trying something new this month! Our youth will submit questions to me and I will answer them as best I can from the Word of God. Here are two questions submitted for the month of June. Here we go!



1. Did God make Himself? Where did He come from?

These are very good questions. According to the Scriptures, God did not make Himself. He has no beginning or end.

Revelation 1:8 KJV

I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

He is the self-existent One. He didn't come from anywhere. He always has and always will exist. This means that He, alone, is God and that He exists without needing the things we need to survive such as oxygen, water, and food.

Exodus 3:14 KJV

And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

No one gives God life. In fact, we get life from Him because He is the Source of all life.

And it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to him must believe that God exists and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him.



2. When children are disobedient, does God tell our parents to punish us?

This is a very good question. And the answer is, wait for it... wait for it...Yes! God tells parents to punish disobedient children. We are all born selfish. We want what we want and couldn't care any less whether or not what we want is good for us. We must be taught what is good by our parents so that we develop into worshippers who honor Christ with our lives. Children who are permitted to do whatever they want to satisfy their desires tend to grow up as adults who do whatever they want to satisfy their desires whether or not it is good, evil, right, wrong, legal, or illegal. If we are not taught to pay consequences for misbehaving, it is very likely we will ruin our lives and our society.

The following is an excerpt from John MacArthur's *The Fulfilled Family*. Please look up the Scriptures he provides and see for yourself what God's Word says about this very important issue!

The Effects of a Disobedient Child

If you have a disobedient child, Proverbs says he will be:

1. A grief to his mother (10:1; 17:25)
2. A rebel to his father (15:5)
3. A sorrow to his father (17:21, 25)
4. A disaster to his father (19:13)
5. A disgrace to his parents (19:26)
6. A user of his parents (28:24)

So, being punished for poor behavior helps us.

Proverbs 29:15, 17

To discipline a child produces wisdom, but a mother is disgraced by an undisciplined child.

Discipline your children, and they will give you peace of mind and will make your heart glad.

God's Word commands us to obey our parents.

Ephesians 6:1-3

Children, obey your parents because you belong to the Lord, for this is the right thing to do. ²“Honor your father and mother.” This is the first commandment with a promise: ³If you honor your father and mother, “things will go well for you, and you will have a long life on the earth.”

Longtime Member Profile

Sister Carolyn Jackson



What is your name, where are you from, and when did you become a member of Union Grove?

My name is Carolyn Jackson. I'm originally from Colquitt, Georgia and I became a member of Union Grove in 1980 under Pastor Bobby Smith.

Tell us about yourself. What are your hobbies? Where do you work? How long have you lived in Warner Robins?

I really don't have any hobbies right now, but I used to collect bells, magnets and shot glasses. I am currently serving as president of the local chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated and the secretary of the Warner Robins Chapter of the Albany State University Alumni which keeps me pretty busy. I retired from Robins Air Force Base on December 31, 2011 after 37 years of service. I was a co-op student from 1974 – 1978 while attending Albany State and have lived in Warner Robins since 1978.

Are you currently serving in a ministry? Or is there a ministry that you are interested in joining?

Can you give any advice to the new members of Union Grove?

I would advise new members to go through the PLACE Workshop to take advantage of the learning opportunities that the church has to offer for the youth as well as the adults. I would also advise them to get involved and to get to know the members...learn, serve, give and connect.

How has being a member of Union Grove affected you?

Being a member has helped me to grow (still growing) and I'm realizing that it's more than attending church once a month (my hometown's church only has service on the first Sunday of each month and Sunday School only fourth Sundays). I've learned the importance of attending Sunday School and Bible Study and not just attending morning service and going home until the next Sunday. I attended most of the churches in the local area when I moved here, but Union Grove is the only one that I ever considered affiliating myself with. It was the one that felt most like family and that is very important since I have no blood relatives in this area. I consider the Grove Zone as my family now.

Is there anything else that you would like to add?

I want to thank those individuals who have taken an interest in me, prayed for me, and encouraged me at times when I really needed it. Lastly, thank you Pastor Clarke for being you!

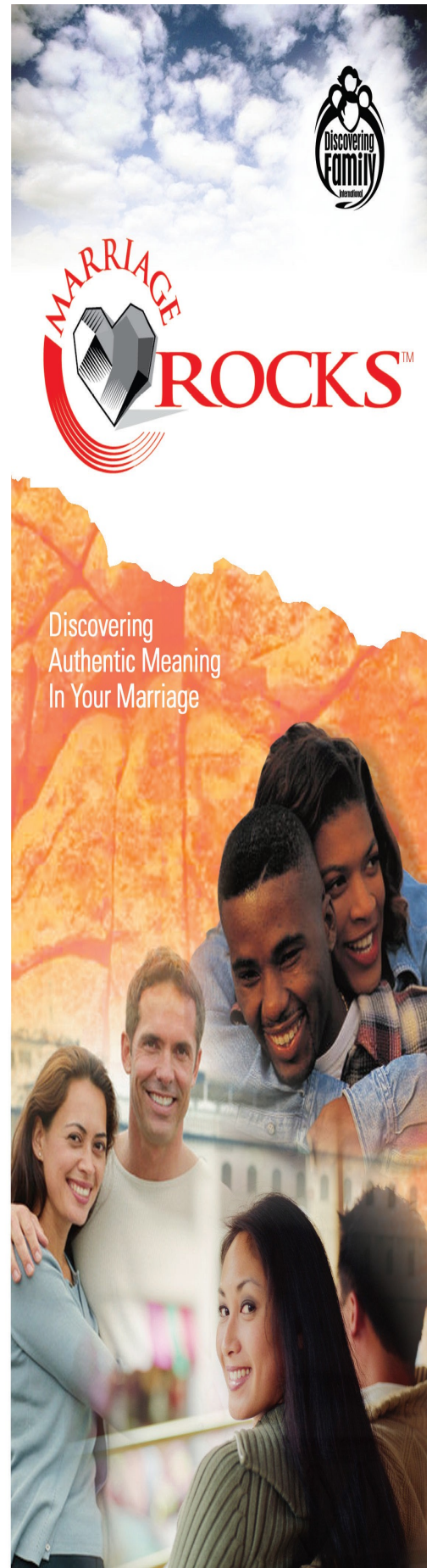

Healthcare Ministry: High Blood Pressure

One of the most dangerous aspects of high blood pressure or hypertension is that you may not know that you have it. There are generally no symptoms of high blood pressure, so you usually don't feel it. In fact, nearly one-third of people who have hypertension don't know it. The only way to find out if you have high blood pressure is to get your blood pressure checked on a regular basis. This is especially important if you have a close relative who has high blood pressure.

High blood pressure affects about one in three adults. Exercise, weight management, and a healthy diet are important ways to help prevent high blood pressure. If you are already on blood pressure medicine, exercise helps the effectiveness of the medication. Be sure to check with your doctor before starting a fitness program.

You don't need to belong to a gym to become more active. Pick an activity that you enjoy. Increase your activity gradually until you are regularly exercising 30 minutes a day up to four times a week. Do you enjoy walking, riding a stationary bike, jogging in place, riding a bicycle, using a treadmill, or swimming? You can start slow or even ask a friend to go with you. But whatever you do, have a doctor certify that you are ready to get started. If you work on base or connected to the military, Robins AFB has some of the best exercise equipment in this area – for free!

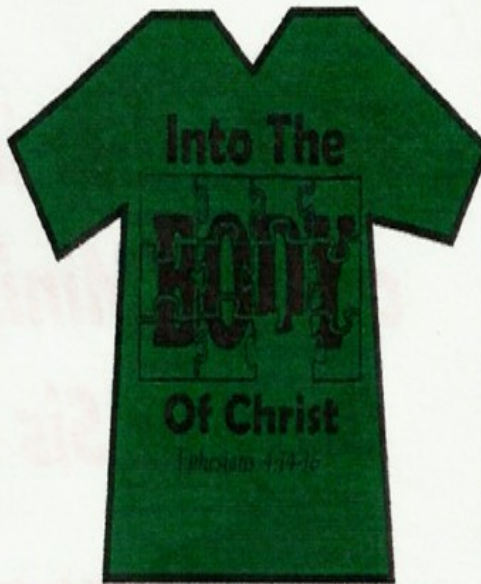
Eating right and exercising will have immediate results – increased energy, weight loss, and a healthier you! If you smoke – do everything you can to eliminate this habit. Untreated high blood pressure can lead to serious diseases, including stroke, heart disease, kidney failure and eye problems. When was the last time you had your blood pressure checked? It only takes a few moments to check your blood pressure. In fact, every Sunday after worship service, a Union Grove healthcare ministry worker will gladly check your blood pressure for you – for free!
